The Workshop

<p>Activity</p>	<p>Great Lakes and Taree Schools Learning Community 2021 Music Workshop</p> <p>During the workshop, your child will be immersed in a musical experience, unlike anything that any single Primary or Secondary School/College can provide. As well as enriching their education in music, the workshop provides the opportunity for participants to mix and meet students from other schools who share music as an interest.</p> <p>The focus will be on playing standard rather than age. This year, we are separating students into two bands; those more capable students who have attended the workshop previously and a beginner band; those who have not attended any previous workshop.</p> <p>The material covered will align with the playing standard. The senior band will be covering more complex material than the beginner band. The beginners will be covering material of a standard expected of a learner who has started playing this year.</p> <p>Students who play in a school band are encouraged to participate.</p>

<p>Arrival and entrance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants are to escort their charge to the Auditorium and seek out a teacher who will note their attendance. Kerri Knight, the workshop coordinator, will be at the Club's Auditorium from 8:30am to meet and greet students as they arrive. Ms Knight will be wearing a high-vis vest. • If Kerri Knight is not in the auditorium to meet students, parents/care providers are asked to wait with their child/ren until a teacher arrives. 		
<p>Transport</p>	<p>Students are to arrange their transport to and from Club Forster.</p> <p>Students from Tuncurry Public School and Forster Public School will return to school by bus in time to meet their usual home routine.</p>		
<p>What to bring</p>	<p>A music stand, your instrument and music including a folder for sheet music (and Essential Elements book).</p>		
<p>Guitarist requirements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can play simple chords: Playing more difficult chords is an advantage. Open chords and Bar chords • Bring an A4 folder. • A guitar capo - if you have one. • A music stand and your instrument - music will be given to you. 		
<p>Food</p>	<p>Bring recess, lunch, a snack and a bottle of water. Please avoid bringing high sugar foods, nut products and watermelon.</p> <p>There is no opportunity to spend money. Students are not permitted access to vending machines.</p>		
<p>Parents</p>	<p>This workshop is supported and heavily subsidised by the NSW Department of Education. This workshop requires at least 80 participants to run. Cancellation of the event - your school will notify you.</p>		
<p>IMPORTANT</p>	<p>Places are limited to 100 so, return your application promptly; first come, first served applies.</p> <p>Returning completed application forms together with payment by the due date to your child's school will guarantee a place in the workshop.</p>

- ➔ Parents/care providers are asked to maintain physical distancing of, at least, 1.5 metres from other families.
- ➔ If you or your child is unwell, please do not attend. Contact your school to advise of your child's absence.
- ➔ Any close contact of a person being tested for COVID-19, should remain isolated until a negative result is confirmed.
